Many of these questions, not all of them, are reprinted from the book Christianity Unmasked, with permission from the author, Dan Israel. If you think that all teachers or even your friends think alike or that you all believe the same things, think again. I'm going to give you some insights that you need to be aware of and a comprehensive list that you should go over, at least verbally, to find out if the person that is leading your group is actually qualified to lead your group. Warning, a false teacher will become very uneasy as you are reading these questions. Most preachers will refuse to answer most of these questions.

Beware of serpents. These serpents look good, smell good and they just might put a hook in your mouth and lead you where ever they want you to go and you will be stupid enough to follow them if you don't know the truth. It only takes a little effort to discover the truth, but most people are not willing to spend the time to discover what the truth really is, so they put their trust in other men to teach them. That is a very dangerous thing to do.

Below is a set of questions that you yourself should examine and then ask your teacher to answer them to determine if you actually agree with him or not.

1. **Pastor, are you licensed by the State to preach?**

These men or women today reach out to the Church/State for licensing. Why is that?

2. **If so, why do you seek permission from the State to preach the Bible?**

There is no scriptural reason for seeking permission from the Church/State.

3. **If so, would that not make you an agent of the State?**

Licensing is a contract with the State that should be disclosed to the laity (the people of the congregation), all of the Terms and conditions of the licensing agency regarding any restrictions or regulations by the Church/State concerning teachings and other "religious" activities should be disclosed and posted in the entrance of the building to be seen and available by all patrons.

4. **Pastor, is your church registered with the IRS as a 501-C3 organization?**
More than likely it is. This exemption forces the worship center and all of its assets to become a corporation under Federal Law. This makes the Church/State, the “God” of that corporation. This exemption qualifies the “church” to be regarded as an entity to be recognized by the Federal Government and thereby allows the Federal Government to regulate its functions according to Federal law. Ask a tax advisor for more accurate information. I am not a tax expert. I have to make that claim here. A corporation is not based in scripture.

5. **If so, how can there be separation between the Church and the State if you seek tax exemption status?**
The State is their “God,” period. The State and the Church are one and the same.

6. **If so, what is your agreement with the government regarding your obligations to maintain your 501-C3 status?**
Ask the Pastor to provide the actual documents of incorporation and the laws that regulate corporate activity. They must ask the State for permission for various activities, Again, The Church/State is their “God.”

7. **If so, can you lose your 501-C3 status if you speak evil of the government?**
Yes they can. They must refrain from campaigning for or against any political candidate or give opinions of governmental activities. Also, there is a clause that prohibits food distribution without a special exemption and must be compliant with governmental, Church/State guidelines.

8. **If so, what is the difference between harlotry, adultery and church incorporation?**
None. According to scripture, they are all one and the same.

9. **Pastor, is it true that Christianity is an official State Sponsored Religion? Is The State and Christianity one and the same? Isn't the purpose of the Church to subdue violent demonstrations against the State by promoting obedience and subservience to the State?**
A State licensed Pastor will argue that this is not the case. However, The Church/State has jurisdiction over all Christian organizations. The Church/State regulates all of the Church's assistance to homeless people, food shelters and clothing outlets. The Church/State routinely publishes Christian based literature and supports Christian based art. i.e. Monuments containing the ten commandments on Church/State property, regulation of marriages and other basic human rights, the swearing in of officials on the Bible and numerous other activities that are supposedly separate from Christian ideologies. I think one can certainly draw the conclusion that Christianity/State and the Church/State are one and the same.

10. **Pastor, how long have marriage licenses been used?**
In the United States, it was the mid 19th century.

11. **Pastor, did your grandparents obtain a marriage license when they got married? If not, then why not?**
They were not required in the United States until the mid 19th century. see above

12. **Pastor, what authority issues a marriage license?**
The Church/State
13. **Pastor, was Joseph and Mary Married when she became pregnant?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will say that she was a virgin and they were not married.
14. **If Joseph and Mary were not married, then why would they have been traveling together? Would this violate Hebrew customs?**
15. **Pastor, do you know what the proper definition of the Hebrew word for virgin is?**
The Hebrew word for virgin simply means "a young maiden." That's it. It has nothing to do with sexual virginity in anyway. Now, the next question is going to shed some light on how we understand some very important concepts.
16. **Pastor, if Mary did get pregnant from Joseph, would they be guilty of committing adultery?**
NO. they would not be guilty of anything other than being a common-law married couple who married without a "traditional, man-made" ceremony. They simply did not have the "traditional, man-made" ceremony. That's all. Couples that have their first experience with sexual intercourse are not committing adultery, they are creating a common-law marriage. They are married. Adultery only occurs when one of them lies with another person while their spouse is still alive. Then and only then can a person commit adultery. So, if Mary was pregnant, it would be from a legitimately formed union between Joseph and Mary. Joseph was thinking about putting her away to keep her from being scorned by the people that she knew because they decided not to wait for the "traditional, man-made" ceremony. The "traditional, man-made" ceremony does not compete the marriage and is, well a man-made tradition. It sounds to me as though the Messiah was even conceived outside of the traditions of man. Go figure.
17. **Pastor, why do we need a marriage license?**
The reason for licensing was to validate inheritances among "licensed" marriages after the death of a spouse. The courts began to invalidate common-law marriages. If you were in a common law marriage in the mid 19th century and your spouse died, the Church/State would refuse to grant the surviving spouse his/her rightful inheritance. The Church/State would then seize the assets and the proceeds would go to the Church/State. If you wanted your property, the Church/State required you to have a legal document, a license, to prove that you are the rightful surviving spouse. Licenses are a Church/State legal instrument and without them, the Church/State will not award the assets to the surviving spouse. This is legal blackmail and is not scriptural in any way.
18. **Pastor, why does the State desire to include itself as a third party to a marriage between two sovereign people?**
To establish Church/State control and authority over potential legal matters regarding inheritances and child custody matters arising from such a union, rather than the precepts of the covenant of YHWH.
19. **Pastor, does a marriage license subject the children of a marriage to the control of the State?**

Yes

20. **Pastor, where do the State "child protection" agencies get their authority over the sanctity of the home?**

From the licensing authority, The Church/State.

21. **Pastor, does requiring a marriage license create a civil marriage or a scriptural marriage?**

Civil only, not scriptural.

22. **Pastor, does a common law marriage require a license?**

No

23. **Pastor, how does common law relate to scriptural law?**

They are the same. Neither involve the Church/State.

24. **Pastor, can you officiate over a non-licensed, common law marriage ceremony?**

No, they cannot. Members of the clergy must have a valid marriage license in hand to officiate over a marriage and they are required to sign and return the license themselves to be a valid license. The clergy are actors of the CHURCH /STATE, THEIR GOD. They are not acting under the authority of YHWH, The Hebrew Elohim.

25. **Pastor, can your license to preach be revoked if you do not comply with Church/State mandated policy?**

Absolutely, The Church/State is their "God."

26. **Pastor, is an unlicensed common law marriage scriptural?**

Yes, but the Pastor nor the Church/State has no jurisdiction regarding a common-law marriage.

27. **Pastor, did Abram and Sarai get a marriage license? Did Issac and Rebekah get a license?**

no and no

28. **Pastor, where in the scriptures is there any mention of a marriage license, even one?**

Nowhere, not even one time.

29. **Pastor, does a marriage license alter, in any way, the responsibility of a man and a woman have toward each other?**

Yes, license allows a woman to sue her husband and obtain child support and custody of the children.

30. **Pastor, isn't it true that a marriage license allows a woman the opportunity to petition the Church/State for relief to go against her husband if she desires a divorce?**

Yes

31. **If so, do you baptize in the name of the father, the son and the holy spirit?**
Matthew 28:19 was added to the book of Matthew in the 13th century to bolster the trinity doctrine. This phrase is not in previous writings of the book of Matthew. Yeshua (Aramaic) or YHWHShI/Yahawashi (Ancient Hebrew) simply said to baptize them in his name, Yeshua (Aramaic) or YHWHShI/Yahawashi (Ancient Hebrew). That does not mean with water. He said, baptizing IN MY NAME, Yeshua (Aramaic) or YHWHShI/Yahawashi (Ancient Hebrew). In other words, I baptize you my brother IN THE NAME OF Yeshua (Aramaic) or YHWHShI/Yahawashi (Ancient Hebrew)! NOT WATER.
32. **If so, can the newly baptized person identify the name in which they were baptized by a licensed Pastor?**
No
33. **Pastor, do you believe in the trinity?**
The trinity is a false doctrine and was proposed in the writings of Tertullian and was later adopted by the RCC in the fourteenth century.
34. **Pastor, in Act 4:12, we learn that there is one one name under heaven by which we must be saved, what is that name?**
Yeshua (Aramaic) or YHWHShI/Yahawashi (Ancient Hebrew), not the pagan Greek anti-Messiah "Jesus."
35. **Pastor, what is the name of the Father and what is the name of His Son, if you know?**
A State licensed Pastor will say, "God," "Lord," "Christ," or "Jesus" These are all pagan State mandated names.
36. **Pastor, isn't it true that the 10 commandments were only given to a very specific culture of people and not to the whole world?**
Yes
37. **Pastor, which culture is considered the "chosen" people according to scripture?**
The nation of Israel, the Israelites, the ecclesia, those who are in covenant with Yeshua
38. **Pastor, do you believe that the Christians have replaced the "chosen people" referred to in scripture?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will say, yes. Christians have not replaced the chosen people of YHWH. Nowhere in scripture is this concept written. Christians didn't exist until 325 AD, 300 years after Yeshua resurrected.
39. **Pastor, do you keep all ten of the original commandments as written in Exodus 20 1-17?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will probably say that no man can keep the commandments. That means that the Pastor does not keep the commandments of YHWH. The Pastor will teach this false teaching to their congregation.
40. **Pastor, who are the people who occupied the land of Israel today?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will say that the descendants of Jacob occupy the land of Israel today. The

fact is that The State of Israel, which are the descendants of Japheth, not Shem are not the descendants of Jacob, Israel.

41. **Pastor, do you use the the word "Lord" or "God" when addressing the Most High of Israel?**

A Church/State licensed Pastor will use these false titles.

42. **Pastor, if the ten commandments were given to a Hebrew people, would it not stand to reason that their deity would be identified as Hebrew in origin and not Greek?**

Yes

43. **Pastor, should we teaching about the Hebrew Messiah instead of the Greek/Roman Jesus?**

A Church/State licensed Pastor will say that they are both one and the same.

44. **Pastor, do you believe that the correct name of the Hebrew Elohim be used in worship?**

Yes, YHWH, not "God"

45. **Pastor, Isaiah 52:6 says that "My People Shall Know My Name," what about anyone who does not know his name?**

They Are Not His People

46. **Pastor, if a person truly has a relationship with "God", shouldn't they know and use his true name and not his title?**

Absolutely

47. **Pastor, isn't it true that the purpose of the priesthood is to teach the people the difference between the clean and the profane, the clean and the unclean?**

Yes

48. **Pastor, Romans 2:24 declares, " For the name of YHWH is blasphemed among the nation through you, as it is written." Can you help us understand this verse?**

Through The Use Of "Lord" And "God"

49. **Pastor, why is the book of Joshua not translated "the book of Jesus" when the original Hebrew name of the Messiah has the exact same spelling as Joshua Son of Nun?**

Because "Jesus" Is A Fake Name

50. **Pastor, is the name "Jesus" Hebrew? Wasn't our saviour Hebrew? Why is "Jesus" used?**

A Church/State licensed Pastor will start going on about transliteration or translational matters. The fact is that there was never a man running around in Israel 2000 years ago by the name of "Jesus," and that's a

fact.

51. Pastor, who is the author of confusion? Who would be the ones in a position to find his agents doing his bidding?

Preachers, Pastors, Teachers, Ministers and Rabbis

52. Pastor, why was the second commandment of Exodus 20:1-17 removed by the RCC?

Because Christianity/State worships idols. How many crosses are in the homes and articles of clothing of Christians?

53. Pastor, have the commandments and the law been done away with?

A Church/State licensed Pastor will say yes. This is not what the Hebrew Messiah or scriptures teach. This is a twisting of the words of Paul to their own destruction.

54. If so, Pastor, why would Messiah tell us that if we love him to keep his commandments?

A Church/State licensed Pastor will reference the two commandments that the Hebrew Messiah mentioned, love "god" and love your neighbor as yourself. This understanding is grossly out of context and exposes his disdain for the words of YHWH and his son and the apostles and the prophets.

55. Pastor, what happens to us if we try to keep the ten commandments today according to Christian teachings?

A Church/State licensed Pastor will claim that these who try to keep the commandments today are treading the blood of Jesus and that those who keep the commandments will go to hell. They believe that no one can keep the commandments and any attempt to do so is an attempt to circumvent the sacrifice of Jesus and obtain righteousness on their own works.

56. Pastor, do you keep the seventh day Sabbath according to Exodus chapter 20?

A Church/State licensed Pastor will begin to argue that we can keep the Sabbath on any day, God knows our hearts. He will argue that the Sabbath was changed to Sunday to celebrate the Sunday resurrection of Jesus.

57. Pastor, why does the fourth commandment start with "remember"?

Because the Sabbath was given from the beginning of creation and has always been for His people only, not the world, certainly not the Christians who are of the world. Christians are not the people of YHWH, they are the people of the Church/State. They have a Church/State licensed Pastor.

58. Pastor, when does the scriptural year begin?

The first lunar conjunction following the spring equinox.

59. Pastor, what is the purpose of the moon?

The moon was given for signs and for seasons to declare the feasts days of YHWH.

60. Pastor, whose birthday is recognized on December 25th?

A Church/State licensed Pastor will say Jesus. December 25th is the birthday of Tammuz as well as all other

Greek/Roman gods and Christs.

61. **Pastor, is there anywhere in scripture that commands or implies that we are worship anyone on his birth?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will say no, but will give an excuse for worshipping his birthday. Such things as the idea that Jesus didn't say not to celebrate his birth or something like that.
62. **Pastor, do you celebrate Christmas?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will always justify celebrating Christmas.
63. **Pastor, do you celebrate Easter?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will always justify celebrating Easter. Easter services typically produce over 40% of the annual revenue for the church. Pastors live and breath for this annual event.
64. **Pastor, what are the three times each year that YHWH's people are to gather together?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor does not have any clue. Pesach, Shabuot and Sukkoth
65. **Pastor, at what age was the Hebrew Messiah baptized?**
30
66. **Pastor, how many long did the ministry of the Saviour last?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will say 3 1/2 years. The Gospels confirm less than one year.
67. **Pastor, what is the difference between a lamb, and a sheep, and why is that significant?**
A lamb is less than one year old. A sheep is over 1 year old. The Messiah was crucified as a lamb. He was our lamb. The time from his baptism to his death was less than one year. Actually, his baptism, was during the previous Feast of Matzot. The Feast of Matzot is the week that the priests are baptized, selected and tested for service in the Priesthood. The Messiah was baptized, approved by the voice of YHWH and tested in the wilderness for the next forty days. This is played out every year with the annual feasts of YHWH.
68. **Pastor, please explain the "wave sheaf."**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will not have an explanation of this event. This is when Yeshua presented himself before His Father, YHWH as the first fruit of the resurrection, harvest, to come on the last Great Day of YHWH when all of the people who are/were in covenant with YHWH will be resurrected.
69. **Pastor, on what day of the week were the people called to the base of Sinai to receive the covenant?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will say Pentecost. It is correctly called Shabuot by those in covenant with YHWH.
70. **Pastor, is there a difference in the Book of the covenant and the Book of the Law?**
Yes

71. **Pastor, where was the Book of the Law placed in regards to the Ark of the Covenant?**
In a side pocket on the outside of the Ark Of The Covenant.
72. **Pastor, what three items were placed inside of the Ark of the Covenant.**
The second copy of the covenant of Exodus 19:5 through Exodus 24:11, the jar of manna and the budded almond branch/staff handed down from Adam to Moses.
73. **Pastor, what was missing from the Ark of the Covenant when Solomon opened the Ark Of The Covenant?**
The jar of Manna and the budded almond branch.
74. **Pastor, how did the Israelites commit adultery?**
They worshipped YHWH in their own way by building an idol of the Egyptian god, Apis, to worship YHWH!
75. **Pastor, was Moses a High Priest? If so, then what Priesthood would he have been a High Priest of?**
Yes, Moses was the last High Priest of The Royal Priesthood in the order of Melchizedek before YHWHShI/Yahawashi/Yeshua.
76. **Pastor, please define the difference between the promise of Genesis 12 and the Covenant of Genesis 15 and how did these relate to the children of Abram 430 years later?**
The fulfillment of the Genesis 12 promise was completed at the time of the Exodus, 430 years later. The first passover was actually the blood ratification and covenant confirming meal of Genesis 12 just prior to the proposal, acceptance, blood ratification and confirmed meal of the new Book of the Covenant at the base of Sinai which the people of Israel broke less than 40 days later by worshipping the golden calf.
77. **Pastor, what Priesthood did Moses transfer to Aaron?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will not know. If he does know, that would be impressive. The answer is the Malkizedek Priesthood, or rather, The Royal Priesthood.
78. **Pastor, was John the Baptizer a High Priest?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor should know this answer. Yes, John the Immerser was the last High Priest of the Aaronic/Levitical Priesthood. John the Immerser transferred the authority of Aaronic/Priesthood Priesthood to Yeshua who was of the order of Malkizedek.
79. **Pastor, what spirit was placed in John the Baptizer?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor should know this answer. It was the Spirit of Elijah.
80. **Pastor, was Zechariah and Elizabeth both High Priests? If so, then was Mary, the mother of the Hebrew Messiah also of the blood line of Aaron?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will say no, but the actual history in scripture confirms that she was in both the blood line of Judah and Aaron. Just as her cousin Elizabeth was.

81. **Pastor, was the Messiah nailed to a tree or hung on a cross?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will say a cross. The scriptures teach that it was a tree. It was actually a very special tree.
82. **Pastor, please explain the Hebrew idiom, "sewing fig leaves together".**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will not know. This phrase is a Hebrew idiom. It means "to sew together excuses."
83. **Pastor, would you be willing to wash the feet every congregant each Sunday before services?**
He probably will not.
84. **Pastor, where in scripture does it say that the followers of Messiah are required to have a Preacher over them?**
He may start to get upset
85. **Is it scriptural that worshipers can fellowship together without having someone in the group constantly dominating and controlling the conversation?**
This is a legitimate question that no one ever considers. I mean, a Pastor gets 20 minutes each week to speak uninterrupted about anything he chooses and the Church/State approves of. No one gets to challenge anything he says during this time. If I am not mistaken, some Church/States are now requiring licensed Pastors to submit audio recordings of their sermons to the Church/State.
86. **Pastor, when did Abrams name change to Abraham occur and why was this timing significant?**
Abrams name was changed after the promise of Genesis 12, the birth of Ishmael and after the Genesis 15 covenant. This name change occurred in Genesis 17, then there was a covenant of circumcision made with Abraham shortly thereafter. In Genesis 21, Issac was born to the recently renamed Abraham. Therefore Ishmael's father is Abram but Isaac's father is Abraham.
87. **Pastor, knowing that a High Priest must officiate over a sacrificial offering, who officiated over the offering that Cain and Abel offered YHWH?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will not know this answer. Adam officiated as High Priest over the sacrifice that Cain and Abel presented before YHWH.
88. **Pastor, what Priesthood would this High Priest have been administrated by?**
The only priesthood in effect at that time was the Royal/Melchizedek Priesthood.
89. **Pastor, what is meant that "Noah was perfect in all of his ways"?**
A Church/State licensed Pastor will say that Noah was a righteous man. If the Pastor says that Noah kept the commandments of "God," then you need to find out what commandments he is referring to. At the time of Noah, the commandments were oral and were not written down. The reason this is significant is because if he says the ten commandments of Moses, then he has no sense of history or of genealogy. Moses was still some one thousand years away from existing at the time of Noah.

90. Pastor, who are the Israelites?

A Church/State licensed Pastor may know this answer. The Israelites are the descendants of Jacob. Jacob was renamed Israel. Therefore, his children are Israelites.

91. Pastor, who was the first Hebrew?

A Church/State licensed Pastor may know this answer. Abraham!

92. Pastor, was Ham, one of Noah's sons a Hebrew?

No

93. Pastor, Who was Nimrods great grandfather?

Noah

94. Pastor, complete the following sentence, "Nimrod was a mighty _____ before YHWH."

"hunter"

95. Pastor, who are the Shemites?

All of the descendants of Shem. The second son of Noah.

96. Pastor, what does the name Isaac mean?

"makes me laugh"

97. Pastor, was Ishmael blessed by YHWH?

Yes

98. Esau sold his birthright for what?

Soup

99. Pastor, what two sons of Israel sought revenge for the rape of their sister Diana?

Simeon and Levi

100. Pastor, who was blessed first, Manasseh or Ephraim?

Ephraim

101. Pastor, why was it necessary for the Israelites to pass through the water when leaving Egypt?

The week that they were in the exodus from Egypt was also the Feast of Matzot, the week of unleavened bread. This Feast week is the week that Priests are baptized, usually on the third day of the week of Matzot, and selected to partake in the Royal Priesthood of Melchizedek. YHWH was making these people a nation of Royal Melchizedek Priests. Having almost 2 million people pass through water would be a great way to baptize all of them into the Priesthood at one time. The following forty days were forty days of testing before they would be invited to become betrothed unto YHWH on the coming Shabuot.

102. Pastor, why was the manna given to the Israelites in the manner that it was given?

The manna was given in the manner that it was given to teach the Israelites the pattern of the week and to relearn the pattern of Shabbat. When they were in Egypt, they had forgotten about the Sabbath, That is why YHWH says in the fourth commandment to remember the sabbath and keep it holy.

103. Pastor, were the second set of commandments a copy of the first covenant and were they part of the first covenant?

This is a tough question to answer. So for those with eyes to see and ears to hear, here goes. The copy that was given to Moses after the original stones were shattered are a copy. This second set of the covenant is what is often referred to as the "commandments written in stone." This copy of the original is the set that Yeshua ratified upon his death. It is the new covenant. This second set that was given after the first set was not blood ratified. You must realize that the original covenant of Exodus 20 through 24:7 was broken before Moses could get back down the mountain. This next set was a copy of a now broken covenant. It did not have the legal weight as the original. It was a copy that was never agreed to, it was never blood ratified or was ever confirmed with a meal. This story can get really deep and I will stop here.

104. Pastor, according to Paul, what was nailed to the tree?

The book of the Law, which includes everything from Exodus 24:12 to the end of Deuteronomy.

105. Pastor, complete this phrase; _____ is the man who hangs from a tree.

106. Pastor, please explain the process to determine how to calculate Shavuot.

You begin on the first day of the week that falls after the weekly Sabbath during the week of Matzot. You then count seven sabbaths then add one day. Shavuot will always fall on the first day of the week fifty days after the sabbath that occurs during the week of Matzot.

107. Pastor, Is it true that the giving of the ten commandments was given at the same time of the year as Shavuot?

Yes

110. Pastor, were in scripture are we told that tax deductions or benefits from the State are received for giving offerings to the church?

111. Pastor, is the term "Holy Mother Church" a reference to the feminine gender thereby qualifying the "Holy Mother Church" to be the one and the same "The Great Harlot" mentioned in Revelation?

Yes
